EYFS PRACTITIONERS – 'High Quality Literacy in the EYFS: Inspiring children to Love to Read and Write'

This session will be led by Early Years Consultant, Sarah Kingham.

Focus:

How what we know about child development, and the technological age in which we and they live, can teach us how to support children as learners of literacy.

- Offer a clearer understanding of the place of 'shared writing' in both adult directed and child initiated learning – scribing children's voice
