# Working Smarter, Not Harder

## Programme

### **SESSION ONE 9.00am - 10.45am**

#### **Starting with Why**

Mr P will start the day by sharing his philosophy towards education and what makes good teaching. He will explain why teachers need to change their mindset to move forward as far as working smarter, not harder.

He will discuss where tools like technology fit in today's classroom and also how other tools such as music can impact the whole curriculum.

### **SESSION TWO 11am - 12.15pm**

#### **Apps to bring the curriculum alive!**

Lee will demonstrate a range of tools to support teaching and learning in the classroom. This will include his three point approach to raising standards in writing through technology by adding a purposeful why to learning. He will also demonstrate how technology can be used to support the teacher in their delivery and planning of effective lessons.

### **SESSION THREE 1pm - 2.15pm**

#### **Striking the right balance!**

He will demonstrate how this approach not only raises standards in writing but every element of the English curriculum, culminating in a performance to show greater depth through fluency.
