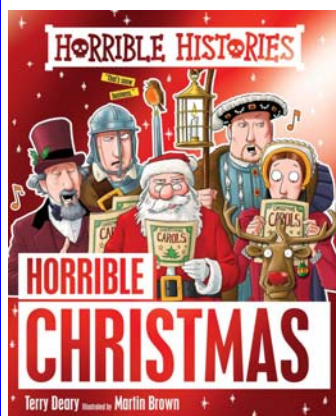


Words we are looking at next week are:
