Activity 1:

Watch the [Video Lesson 4](#). - Quel âge as-tu ? Then practise the vocabulary learnt using [the activity sheet 4a](#).

Activity 2 :

Listen to the [Radio Show](#) and let us know how interesting and accessible you are finding it. Then practise the vocabulary using the [activity sheet 4b](#).

As an extension, you can try the challenge: Quel est ton numéro de téléphone?

Can you work out what this question means? Some of the words look quite like English words: what do you think numéro means? What about téléphone?

The question means “what is your phone number” in French. Your challenge is to learn how to say your phone number using the numbers you now know, and there is one extra number you'll need to find out: how do you say “zero” in French?

That's your challenge for this lesson!
