Remember: Don't do the two activities in one go! It's better for your long-term memory that you practise French a few times a week.

Activity 1: Lesson 7 - Les couleurs

To practise further, look at the word search in the [Activity 7a](#) .

Activity 2: Recall and practise naming colours

Listen to the [Radio Show 7](#) to revise yesterday's words and learn new colours.

In the same way you did it with numbers, you can practise your French even when no-one else is around. For the next days, every time you see something rouge, say rouge to yourself. Every time you see something bleu, say bleu to yourself, and every time you see something blanc, say blanc to yourself. It may even help if you start to think about the things you see regularly, the curtains in your bedroom, the colour of your bed, and so on. Remember to use your best French accent even when you're talking to yourself!

Remember that at all times you can sing along to French songs you have learnt in Yr2 chosen from the Rhodes Avenue [Yr2 Pinterest Board](#) and listen to stories in [French Stories](#).
