

Bonjour les enfants ! Comment ça va ?

Let's travel to Paris with Emma and Mathilde and do two activities this week about this beautiful capital city.

Remember: Don't do the two activities in one go! It's better for your long-term memory that you practise French a few times a week.

Activity 1: À Paris

Watch the [video lesson 10- À Paris](#), and read the [Vocabulary List](#).

I was wondering if you can answer the following question like we did in class:

- *Quelle est la capitale de la France ?*
- *C'est.....*

Oui très bien ! C'est Paris ! (remember in French we don't pronounce the "s" in the word Paris). Consonants are generally not pronounced at the end of French words.

Do you remember why Paris begin with a capital letter?

Paris is a proper noun like your name. That's why we are writing them with a capital letter. Do you know any other proper noun in French?

Activity 2: Practise naming monuments:

Listen to the [radio show 10](#) to review the name of famous monuments in Paris:

- La Tour Eiffel
- l'Arc de Triomphe
- Le Louvre
- La cathédrale Notre-Dame

I was wondering if you can say some French sentences like we did in class:

- À Paris, il y a la Tour Eiffel et L'Arc de Triomphe.
- À Paris, il y a.....
