This week we have planned 2 activities for you to do during the week to review the colours in French !

Do you remember the song [BOUM BOUM BOUM les feux d'artifice](#)? I am sure you will enjoy singing along to it again.

Remember: Don't do the two activities in one go! It's better for your long-term memory that you practise French a few times a week.

### **Activity 1: Lesson 7 - Les couleurs**

Watch the [Video Lesson 7- les couleurs](#), and read the [Notes for Teachers 7](#), I am sure you are already very familiar with those.

To practise further, look at the [Vocabulary List](#). Can you spot two colours in the list that are different from what we said in class?

1. For purple they are also mentioning "pourpre", like "purple" in English. Whereas "violet" is "identique" to violet.
2. What is used for brown ? The girls are saying "brun" instead of "marron". Brun is used in French for hair and fur colour like this: "j'ai les cheveux bruns" (I have brown hair), "j'ai un chien brun" (I have a brown dog).
