Activity 1:

As an extension, Can you match the French days of the week with their English translation?

lundi	Thursday
mardi	Tuesday
mercredi	Saturday
jeudi	Friday
vendredi	Monday
samedi	Sunday
dimanche	Wednesday

Did you notice that the days of the week are common nouns in French? That's why they don't begin with a capital letter. Of course, there is a capital letter if these nouns are used at the beginning of a sentence like:

"Lundi 6 juillet"

Activity 2:

Listen to the [Radio Show 14](#) to review the days of the week.

As an extension you might wish to watch [Papo](#) visiting a French school: can you spot the French teacher "maîtresse" writing the date on the black board? Which day of the week is she writing ?
