
Money Raised


How was the money raised this year?


Although the impact of Covid-19 restricted the number of event and activities, £15k was raised (44% of 2018/19 total) in the period up to January 2020 with increased profitability from the Christmas Fair, Jumble Sale and Cake Sale vs. PY.





6 Year view of money spent











