Information about Yr2 French at Rhodes Avenue

Yr2 pupils enjoy an initiation to French with **Camembear**, mainly singing songs to learn how to produce French sounds and be introduced to some basic French vocabulary. These songs will be reviewed in KS2 to learn French **phonics**, expand the **vocabulary** and give examples



of **grammar** within an authentic context.

Here are the topics covered this year, mainly through songs, stories and games:

- Greetings & exchanging politeness
- Introduction to French culture and traditions like Epiphany & Easter celebrations
- Colours
- Months and celebrating birthdays
- Numbers 1-10
- Animals and genders
- Family members
- The Weather
- Parts of the body
- Ordering ice-cream

Additional songs are learnt that are linked to the class topic, like “Au feu les pompiers” when the Great Fire of London is being studied.
