

Reception Home Learning – Week beginning 17th January, 2022

This week:

This week we have continued exploring 'Emily Brown and the Thing'. The children have used their imagination and created their own 'Thing'. We also focused on some of the key vocabulary in the text e.g. distract, tangled, thorniest, windowsill etc.

Our keywords for this week is 'he' and 'she'

In maths, we have continued to focus on one less within 10. This can be a trickier concept for some children. We used objects and number lines to show the children that one less means taking 1 away.

Our number of the week is '12'

Parents' Information:

Please be reminded that your child should have a spare clothes bag with suitable clothes for the season available for them at school. Some children prefer to have their own clothes instead of wearing the school spares, so please ensure your child's bag is at school. Please ensure that all items are labelled with your child's name.

Sharing a Story

Sharing a story daily enhances your child's learning immensely. We ask that when you are reading a story, maybe before bedtime, that you ask questions about the text, e.g. How is the character feeling?; Can you think of a different ending to the story?; Are there any clues in the pictures?; etc. This helps children to understand the story and it develops comprehension and language skills.

Something to do

One less - Focusing on the vocabulary less

You can do practical activities with your child focusing on the word less e.g. count the objects of their choice and then ask them what is one less than that amount – you have 7 cars, what is one less than 7?

Extension – Choose a number and find one less on the number line. They can then write the number.
