We have introduced our new core text — 'Astro Girl' by Ken Wilson Max. We looked at an illustration from the 'end papers' and discussed it as a whole class before reading the story. This prompted lots of speaking and listening opportunities and the children used vocabulary linked to space and the night sky.

In maths, we have looked at repeating patterns — recognising the repeating pattern, continuing it and creating our own. We followed ABAB patterns and added additional challenge for those children who needed it with ABBABB patterns as well.

Our number of the week is number 7.

This week we have learnt about Diwali, The Festival of Light. We celebrated by reading the story of Rama and Sita, creating diva lamps and rangoli patterns, and learning how Hindu's acknowledge this festival as celebrating good over evil and light over darkness. Thanks to the parents who helped contribute to the children's learning experience about Diwali.

We also learnt about Remembrance Day, to remember the armed forces who have fought to help us. The children created poppies to mark the occasion.

Sharing a story

Something to do

Repeating patterns:

Start a repeating pattern for your child (you could use food items or toys, e.g. grape, blueberry, grape, blueberry) and ask them to tell you what your repeating pattern is. Let them have a go at continuing your repeating pattern and then encourage them to try to create their own.

If they find it challenging to create an ABAB pattern independently, try lots of examples together instead, talking all the time about what you have created and how it repeats.
